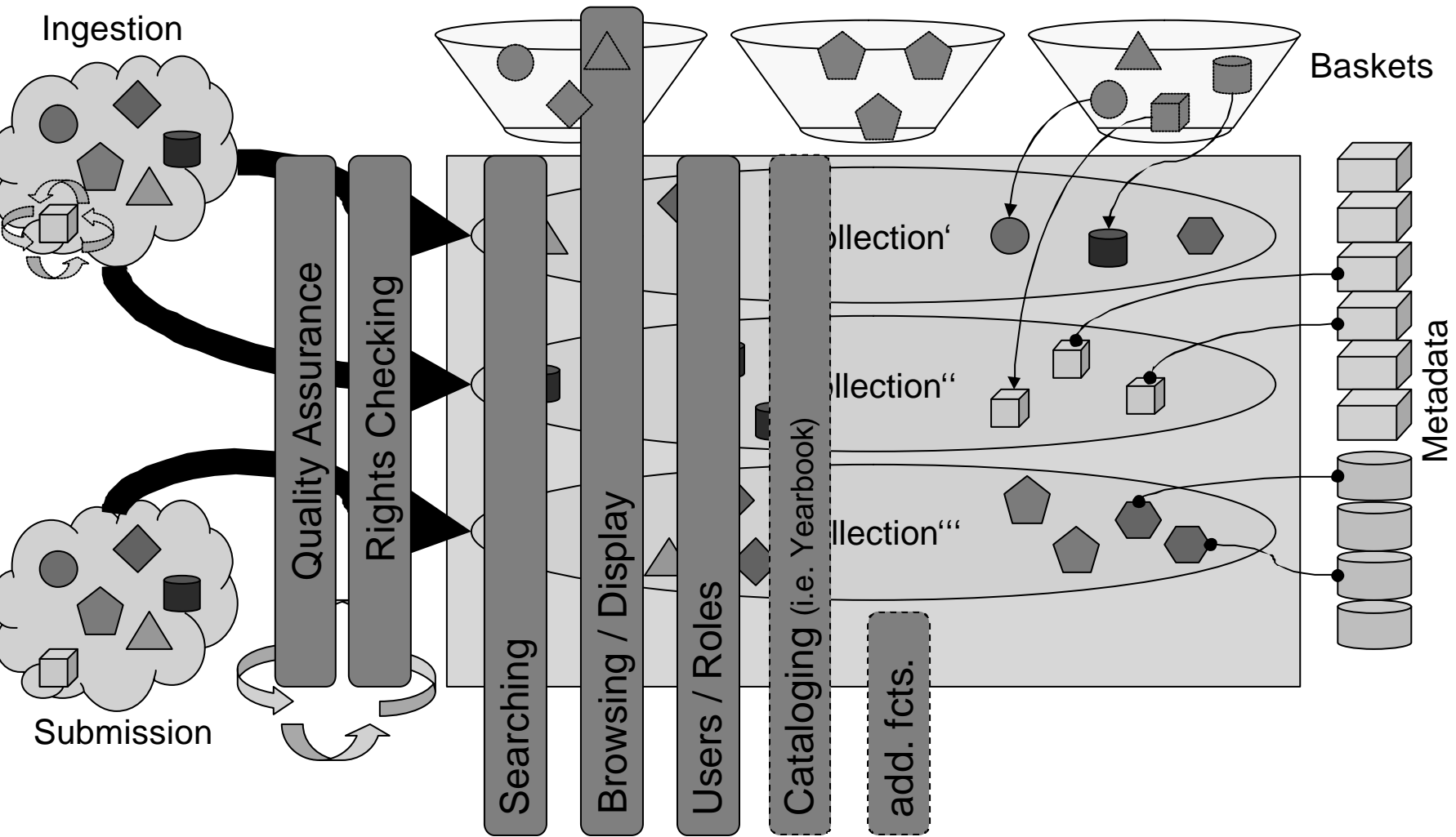

## Scope and Preconditions for defining Release I

- Limited functionalities in “*production like*” environment, but no “*production release*” with the aim to replace eDoc:
  - Established functions remain in established Systems
  - Yearbook in a later Release
  - Reporting Tool will be developed in parallel
- Maxim: Focusing on user functionalities:
  - First: User related functions
  - Later on: Administrative interfaces and production tasks

## Goals and Benefits of Release I

- Point out the advantages and future readiness (sustainable and flexible system)
- Implement the significant functional scope of PubMan application, but not all functionalities in depth
- Avoid rebuild of functionalities
- Plattform to verify functionalities and preliminary interfaces

## **Submission (Basics)**

- One standard interface; No IP suggestion

## **Using Authority Files (Basics)**

- Exemplarily for one/few metadata elements (e.g. authors); Select items; Browse through; No administration

## **Quality Assurance (Basics)**

- Sample workflows; No administration

## **Rights Checking (Basics)**

- Sample workflows; No administration

## **Using Collections (Basics)**

- Submit items to; Use within QA and RC workflow

## **Metadata of Items (Basics)**

- Select; Edit; Save

## **Searching**

- Basic Possibilities where needed

## **Browsing / Displaying**

- Basic Possibilities where needed

## **Workflow**

- Included where useful; defined Examples; no Administration

## **Users / Roles**

- Included where useful; defined Examples; no Administration

## **Import / Export Data**

- XML-based (e.g. to import eDoc-Data via XML)

## **Versioning of Items (Basics)**

- Implicite system tracking of changes

- • **Entry Point per Institute (static layout; dynamic content)**
  - (Effort – Basics: middle rate)
- • **Citation Counts**
  - (Effort – middle rate (maybe easy))
- • **Expert Search**
  - (Effort – middle rate to complex (depends on requirements))
- • **Indexing / Searching of domain specific data (e.g. formula)**
  - (Effort – Search: easy to middle rate; Indexing: special)
- • **Researcher Workspace (static layout; dynamic content)**
  - (Effort – Basics: easy to middle rate)
- SRU/SRW-Interface (XML-based)** (Input for local Researcher WS)
  - (Effort – not estimated)

## **ID-Fetch**

- (Effort – not estimated)

## **Multiple Item Edit**

- (Effort – middle rate)

## **History of Affiliation**

- (Effort – very complex)

## **Working with Baskets**

- (Effort – easy to middle rate)

## **Versioning**

- (Effort – Basics: easy; User Access: complex)
